Russian University of State for Social (RUSS) is the main university of social sciences in Russia. It is century-old and has rich history. RUSS is the ideological heir of the Sverdlov Communist University and the Higher Party School under the CPSU.

Today, RUSS combines traditional values and innovative approaches in the educational process, training successful and highly qualified specialists in popular modern fields.

HISTORY OF RUSS

1919

By the Order of the Plenum of the CPSU CC of July 3, 1919, the Sverdlov Communist University was founded.

1932

By the Decree of the CPSU CC of September 21, 1932, the Sverdlov Communist University was renamed into the Sverdlov Higher Communist Agricultural University. By the Decree of the CEC Presidium of June 28, 1933, The Sverdlov All-Union Communist Agricultural University was awarded with the Order of Lenin.

1939

By the Decree of the CPSU Politburo of June 25, 1939, the All-Union Communist Agricultural University was renamed into the Higher Party School under the CPSU.

1990

By the Resolution No.5 of the Central Committee of the Russian Communist Party of December 28, 1990, Moscow Higher Party School was renamed into the Institute of Social and Political Problems under the Central Committee of the Russian Communist Party.

1991

By the Order of the Russian Communist Party Politburo of March 27, 1991, the Institute of Social and Political Problems under the Central Committee of the Russian Communist Party was renamed into Russian Socio-Political Institute of the CEC of the Russian Communist Party. By the Order No.15 of the Government of the RSFSR of November 25, 1991, Russian State Social Institute under the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the RSFSR was founded. It inherited the rights and obligations of Russian Socio-Political Institute of the CEC of the Russian Communist Party to employ professors and workers and continue the training of students and postgraduates.

1994


By the Order No. 642 of the State Committee of the Russian Federation for Higher Education of July 01, 1994, and the Order No. 145 of the Ministry of the Social Protection of the Population of the Russian Federation of August 10, 1994, Russian State Social Institute under the Ministry of the Social Protection of the Population of the RSFSR was renamed into Moscow State Social Institute.

2004

Based on the Resolution of the Governmental Commission on issuing permits for the use of the names "Russia", "The Russian Federation" of March 24, 2002 (Protocol No. 2), by the Order No. 711 of the Federal Agency for Education of July 21, 2005, Moscow State Social University under the Ministry of Labor and Social Development of the Russian Federation was renamed into Russian State Social University (later on — Russian University of State for Social).

Konstantin Chernenko

General Secretary of the CPSU Central Committee from February 13, 1984 to March 10, 1985, Chairman of the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR from April 11, 1984 to March 10, 1985. Member of the CPSU since 1931, the Central Committee of the CPSU — since 1971, member of the Politburo of the Central Committee of the CPSU since 1978.



Yuri Andropov

The head of the USSR in 1982–1984. General Secretary of the CPSU Central Committee, Chairman of the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR. Chairman of the USSR State Security Committee. Secretary of the CPSU Central Committee on Ideology in 1982 and Secretary of the CPSU Central Committee, member of the Politburo of the CPSU Central Committee since 1973. Deputy of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR of the 3rd and 6th–10th convocations. Hero of Socialist Labor, holder of four Orders of Lenin.



Mikhail Koshkin

Soviet design engineer, creator and first chief designer of the T-34 tank, head of the Tank Design Bureau of the Comintern Kharkov Locomotive Plant. Hero of Socialist Labor.



Dmitry Polyansky

Soviet statesman and party leader, Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the RSFSR. First Deputy Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the USSR. Minister of Agriculture of the USSR. Member of the Presidium — Politburo of the Central Committee of the CPSU. Member of the Bureau of the Central Committee of the CPSU for the RSFSR. Ambassador of the USSR in Japan and Norway.



Deng Xiaoping

Representative of the politicians of the older Chinese generation, he was a member of the "eight immortals", which included the most important veterans of the Chinese revolution. He was the de facto leader of China from the late 1970s to the early 1990s.



Ho Chi Minh

Chairman of the Central Committee of the CPV, Vietnamese revolutionary, statesman, military and political figure





RUSS conducts research in all key areas of human life, society and the state.
